WHC certifies over 600 certified programs worldwide with efforts that range from small rain gardens in inner city manufacturing facilities to multi-acre efforts on reclaimed mining land.



24 projects are possible to address species like pollinators, birds, bats and amphibians; habitats like grasslands, landscaped areas, forests and wetlands and; education efforts like STEM, community outreach and employee training.
