SP EHS Forum Meeting
July 14, 2020

DRAFT MEETING MINUTES

Kellen Mahoney, SP, opened the meeting at 2:00pm. He reviewed SP's antitrust guidelines and recommended that everyone indicate in their notes of the meeting that the guidelines were reviewed and that they would be complied with. Jack Nunes, Lear and SP EHS Forum Co-Chair, noted that the SP EHS Forum is intended to provide an opportunity for deeper discussion, networking and exchange of ideas on key EHS topics of interest to the members. He noted that the purpose of today's meeting is to share examples of adaptive innovation in response to COVID and commented on Lear's experience related to this.

Kellen then introduced the speakers for the session:

- Scott Nadler, Nadler Strategy, shared strategies for maintaining sustainability programs through disruption and lessons learned from COVID which can apply to climate and other sustainability disruptions.
- Jason Haelzle and Ryan Apps, GHD, presented an example of working with a large auto assembly facility in Canada with safely, rapidly and repeatedly bringing their workforce back for production, and shared strategies and technologies available to support business continuity efforts from response to recovery to resiliency.
- Susan Robinson, WM, shared examples of how WM adapted its services, workforce and customer communications in response to COVID, and lessons learned for sustainable materials and recycled-content programs going forward, including using this opportunity to educate consumers on the value of recycling.
- Mark Cleveland, Hytch, discussed the impact of COVID on commuter behavior and shared mobility, and ways in which the Hytch platform has adapted, including how employers / communities are tracking and rewarding desired behaviors, which might include sheltering in place, physical distancing, sharing rides with fellow associates, reducing CO2 impact, while collecting data that can support contact tracing if/when needed.
- Kathryn Lintner, Kristiansson LLC, shared a suite of online solutions their team have developed to support companies in COVID risk assessment, training and mitigation efforts, and opportunities to assess COVID risk within supply chains using self-assessment tools.

John Bradburn, ERA Environmental, also shared an update on ERA's SERV App and collection of data on companies' COVID response efforts.

ACTION ITEMS

- SP will distribute a quick survey to prioritize topics for future EHS Forum meetings. The next SP EHS Forum is planned to be scheduled in conjunction with SP's Q4 2020 meeting.

The SP EHS Forum meeting adjourned at 4:00pm.
